

## THE WNDB INTERNSHIP GRANT PROGRAM



The WNDB Internship Grant Program provides supplemental grants to applicants from **diverse backgrounds** (including, but not limited to, LGBTQIA, Native, people of color, gender diversity, people with disabilities, and ethnic, cultural, and religious minorities) who wish to pursue a career in children's publishing. Eligibility is subject to review by the WNDB Internship Committee. Each chosen grant recipient will receive \$3,000.

### Eligibility

1. Applicant must identify as coming from a diverse background as specified in WNDB's definition of diversity: <http://bit.ly/aboutWNDB>
2. Applicant must have received a paid internship offer from one of our Partner Publishers or Literary Agencies. See link below for a list of our Partners. The position must be at least half time, minimum wage based on the Partner's state requirements.
3. For Children's Publishers, the internship must be exclusively in the children's division. For Children's literary agencies, the intern must spend 50% of their time working on children's books.
4. For Adult Publishers, the internship must be exclusively in the adult division. For Adult literary agencies, the intern must spend 100% of their time working on adult books.

### FAQs

1. Do I need to be a Creative Writing/English Major to apply for publishing internships or be eligible for this grant?  
**No. We encourage students from all majors/disciplines who enjoy reading and value diverse representation in all aspects of storytelling to apply.**
2. Does my publishing internship have to be in-person to qualify for this grant?  
**No. Due to COVID-19, many of our Partners are offering remote internships this summer.**
